Attendance and Anonymous Income Survey

During October the Church of England collects statistics on attendance – this figure forms part of the formula to determine Parish Share - so you will see someone counting numbers carefully at each service. Secondly, the anonymous income survey. The amount we are required to pay to the Diocese and wider church is also based on the average income of regular attenders. To calculate an accurate figure anonymous income surveys need to be completed by those who are 16 and over and regularly attend this church as their main place of worship, which is considered to be more than 12 times a year.

The **responses go into a sealed box** so no one here sees the result. It is important to remember it is your personal income, not that of the family, AND those who have little or no income also take part to give a true average.
